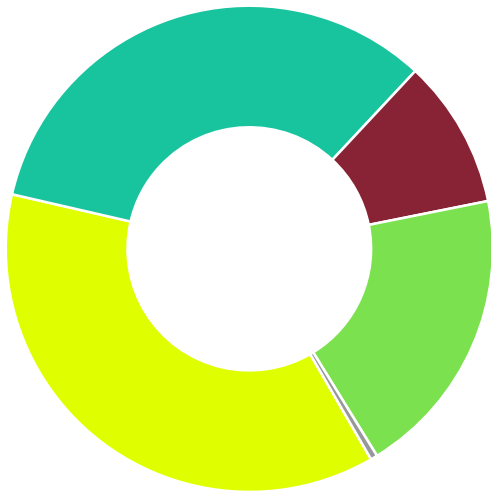

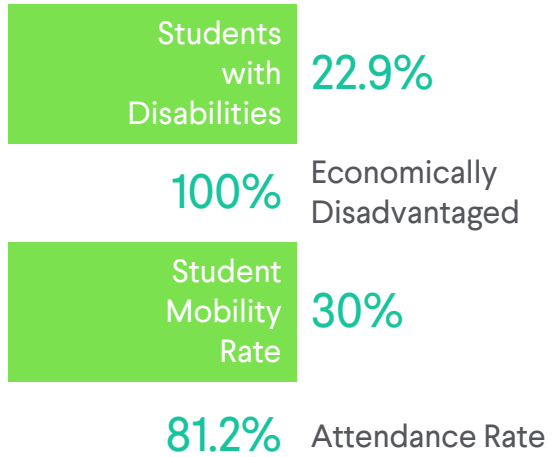
Student Demographics

Progress towards Goals

The percent proficient in ELA on the state assessment increased from 31.4% in SY2024 to 46.3% in SY2025.

The percent proficient in Math on the state assessment increased from 29.2% in SY2024 to 40.4% in SY2025.

Student attendance increased from SY2024 to SY2025 by one percentage point, and the chronic absenteeism rate decreased by nearly 2 percentage points.

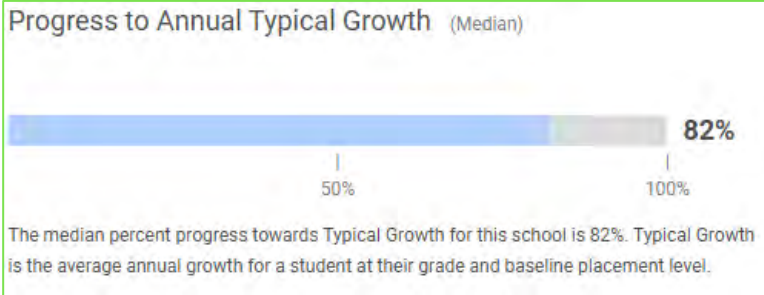

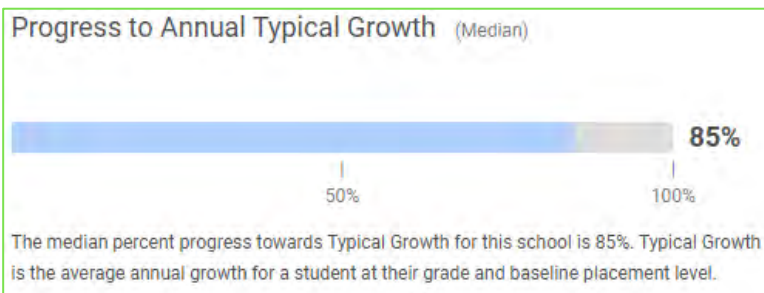

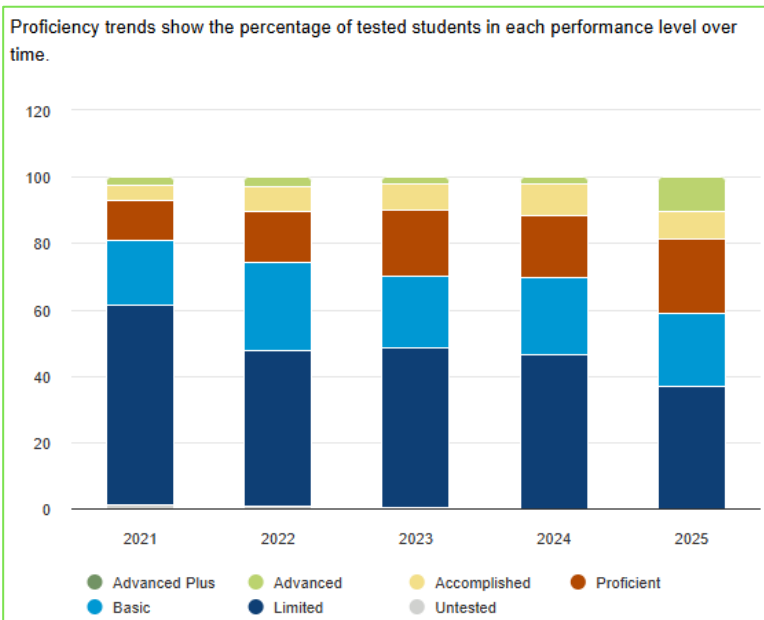
iReady Data Reading

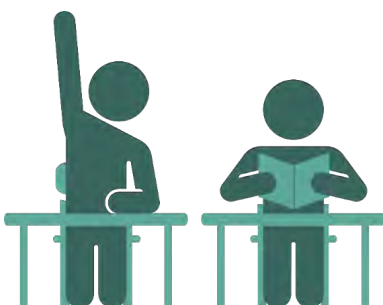
